A new law to support **student safety**

If you or someone you know is in immediate danger, call **triple zero (000)**.

A new law is here to make campuses and student accommodation safer for students. The Higher Education Gender-based Violence Regulator will monitor and enforce provider compliance with the new law, called the National Higher Education Code to Prevent and Respond to Gender-based Violence (National Code). Find out more at **studyassist.gov.au**

It sets out requirements for higher education providers to prevent and respond to gender-based violence. Gender-based violence is physical or non-physical violence or abuse against someone based on their gender, that harms, controls, or causes fear.

If you or someone you know is feeling unsafe or has been affected by gender-based violence, talk to your provider, both for support and to report.
