What's a University Study Hub?

University Study Hubs are welcoming, inclusive spaces that help students in regional, remote, and outer suburban areas access and succeed in tertiary education, closer to home.

While Study Hubs aren't education providers, they make it easier to study with access to study spaces, support services, and connection with other students.

Each Hub is shaped by its community, with staff tailoring services to the needs of local students.

What's available at a Study Hub?

Facilities and support services vary between locations, but typically include:



quiet study spaces



IT/video conferencing equipment



high-speed internet



break-out spaces



kitchen amenities



after-hours access



academic skills support



help with admin tasks



study pathways/course options



career pathways/employment advice



wellbeing support



a local student community

Who can use a Study Hub?

Domestic students enrolled with an Australian university or vocational education and training (VET) provider can register for free access to the facilities and services at the Study Hubs.

Where are they?

In 2026, there will be **71 University Study Hubs** across Australia, thanks to the Australian Government's \$66.9 million commitment to expand access and support for tertiary students, and those considering further study.

Hubs are located in communities where going to university hasn't always seemed possible. There are:

56 Regional University Study Hubs (RUSH) in regional and remote areas of Australia

15 Suburban University Study Hubs (SUSH) in the outer suburbs of Australia's major cities.
