Variation Agreement extending the Bilateral Agreement Between South Australia and the Commonwealth

Preliminaries

- 1. In accordance with clause 22 of the National School Reform Agreement, the Parties agree to amend the Bilateral Agreement Between South Australia and the Commonwealth (the Agreement) as set out in this Variation Agreement.
- 2. In December 2022, Education Ministers agreed to undertake a review to inform the next National School Reform Agreement. To enable time for this review, Education Ministers agreed to extend the current National School Reform Agreement for 12 months, subject to agreement from First Ministers. This Agreement will be extended for the same period.

Variations to the Agreement

1. The Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1.	Clause 3	'31 December 2023' is replaced with '31 December 2024'.
2.	Clause 33	In clause 33, 'from 2018 to 2023' is replaced with 'from 2018 to 2024'.
3.	33	After the final column in the table in clause 33, add an additional column titled '2024' with '75.00%' in the row dealing with the Government sector, and '19.72%' in the row dealing with the Non-government sector.
4.	Subclause 34(c)	In subclause 34(c), 'through to 2023' is replaced with 'through to 2024'.
5.	Clause 35	In clause 35, 'from 2018 to 2023' is replaced with 'from 2018 to 2024'.
