## Variation Agreement extending the Bilateral Agreement Between Queensland and the Commonwealth

## **Preliminaries**

- 1. In accordance with clause 22 of the National School Reform Agreement, the Parties agree to amend the Bilateral Agreement Between Queensland and the Commonwealth (the Agreement) as set out in this Variation Agreement.
- In December 2022, Education Ministers agreed to undertake a review to inform the next National School Reform Agreement. To enable time for this review, Education Ministers agreed to extend the current National School Reform Agreement for 12 months, subject to agreement from First Ministers. This Agreement will be extended for the same period.

Variations to the Agreement

3. The Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

5.	Table after clause 26	In the final column in the table after clause 26, add an additional column titled '2024' with 70.50% for the row dealing with the Government sector, and 20.00% in the row dealing with the Nongovernment sector.
